About the Organisations Attending...

Dementia-Coordinators from Age UK will be able to give guidance and information on support services for people living with dementia and their carers to improve their quality of life.

Girling's Solicitors will offer legal advice regarding queries about Power of Attorney, Deputyship and Mental Capacity Assessments.

Social Workers from Kent County Council can advise on cost of care, options for long-term residential placements and befriending services.

The Memory Assessment Service has Support Workers and an Admiral Nurse who attend the Drop-in Clinics regularly. We can support both clients and carers alike with coping strategies and community-based resources.
